

Objectives and Format of Workshop

Emphasis on therapeutic endoscopy: technique, indications limitations and pitfalls. In particular in this year's workshop we will be introducing several new sophisticated procedures which we want our participants to learn, appreciate their utility but at the same to be critical about its application and usefulness in our daily clinical practice.

Procedures will include direct cholangioscopy, endoscopic ultrasound, enhanced imaging endoscopy, endoscopic submucosal dissection of gastric and colonic neoplasm as well as endoscopic myotomy for achalasia of the cardia (POEM). A special session will be dedicated to the use of the special OTSC clips for perforation and fistulas in the GI tract.


Phillip Chiu Hong Kong, China

Horst Neuhaus Dusseldorf, Germany



Professor Neuhaus is Head of the Department of Internal medicine as well as the Head of the Gastroenterology and GI Endoscopy units in the Teaching Hospital University of Dusseldorf, Germany.

Krish Rangunath Nottingham, UK

Professor Rangunath is Professor and Chair in GI Endoscopy, University of Nottingham, Head of Endoscopy and Honorary Consultant Gastroenterologist, Nottingham Digestive Diseases Centre & Biomedical Research Unit, Queens Medical Centre Campus, Nottingham, United Kingdom. Dr Rangunath is an accomplished therapeutic endoscopist with outstanding research and publications in image enhanced endoscopy in Barrett's esophagus and in early mucosal lesions of the esophagus and stomach.

Dong-Wan Seo Seoul, Korea

Professor of Medicine at University of Ulsan Medical College and Consultant Therapeutic Endoscopist at the Asan Medical Centre, Seoul, Korea. Professor Seo is a graduate of the prestigious Seoul National University and trained throughout his career at the Asan Medical Center. He was visiting professor at the University of Washington, Seattle for two years from 2001-2003. Professor Seo is an expert in ERCPs and EUS with a special interest in percutaneous transhepatic cholangioscopy.

Yun-Sheng Yang Beijing, China

Professor Yang or “Sunny” is an outstanding gastroenterologist, therapeutic endoscopist as well as a leader in gastroenterology in China where he heads the Gastroenterology and Hepatology Unit and the Endoscopy Unit at the famous 3rd Chinese People’s Liberation Army Hospital in Beijing, China. The 3rd PLA Hospital is one of the largest hospitals in the world with an immense GI and endoscopy service. Presently Professor Yang is the President Elect of the Chinese Society of Gastroenterology and the Vice President of the Chinese Society of Digestive Endoscopy.



Ian Yusoff Perth, Australia

Dr Yusoff is also a Malaysian in origin. He is a top class therapeutic endoscopist with a focus on biliopancreatic endoscopy. He is an expert at both ERCPs and EUS. In addition he is a teacher par excellence and has taken several Malaysian trainees under his wings in Perth.

Wang Ping Shanghai, China

Ms Wang Ping is head nurse of endoscopy center, as well as associate chief nurse superintendent of the famous Zhongshan Hospital, Fudan University, Shanghai, China. She has published several papers and books and book chapters on various aspects of endoscopic nursing. In addition she has also organised several endoscopic nursing workshops and meetings in China, She has previously worked in Shizuoka, Japan as well as in the Prince of Wales Hospital, Hong Kong.

Citation by Associate Professor Dr Ida Hilmi (University of Malaya)



Horst Neuhaus is Head of the Department of Internal Medicine, Evangelisches Krankenhaus Düsseldorf and Chief of Service of the Department of Gastroenterology (one of the OMED Centers of Excellence and an ESGE training center).

He graduated from the University of Bonn, Germany, in 1979 and completed his residency and training in gastroenterology in 1987. He subsequently became a faculty member and Head of the Endoscopy Unit in the Department of Medicine, Technical University of Munich under the leadership of Professor Meinhard Classen.

In 1992, Horst Neuhaus obtained his “Habilitation” at the Medical Faculty of Technical University of Munich. The thesis was on “In vitro and in vivo studies on electromagnetic shock-wave lithotripsy of gallbladder stones”. He became Associate Professor of the same faculty in 1999. Since 1995, Professor Neuhaus was appointed as Chief of the Department of Internal Medicine of the Evangelisches Krankenhaus Düsseldorf which is the teaching hospital of the University of Düsseldorf. His position includes Chief of Service of the Department of Gastroenterology which is a high volume tertiary referral endoscopy center. He has been founder and director of the annual Düsseldorf International Endoscopy Symposium since 1999 and last year the symposium had over 1600 participants from 50 different countries.

Horst Neuhaus has served as President of the European Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (ESGE), Councillor of the United European Gastroenterology Foundation (UEGF), Councillor of the German Society of Gastroenterology (DGVS) and the German Society of Endoscopy and Imaging Procedures (DGE-BV). He has a wide field of clinical and scientific interests which include diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopy, biliary and pancreatic diseases and diagnosis and endoscopic treatment of early gastrointestinal neoplasms. He has published extensively in these areas and is on editorial boards of several international journals. He is married to Silvia and they have one son who is also a physician.

In Memoriam



Associate Professor Dr Salem Omar
(1968 - 2012)

On 10th December 2012, the Gastroenterology Unit of University Malaya Medical Centre, and the Faculty of Medicine of University of Malaya, lost a prominent and formidable member of staff in the passing of Associate Professor Dr Salem Omar. Salem, as he was fondly known, was a unique colleague and friend to many. An IT “geek” from his early days in medical school and subsequently as a doctor, he was early to embrace mass electronic communication to many even before the advent of electronic social media. Most of us will remember his early announcements of “increases in petrol prices” or “changes to the government salary structure” even before these things were in mass media print. He was ever helpful to those who were IT-illiterate. Through personal interest, he developed expertise in the area of electronic mass media communication, which eventually led to him becoming a key member of the APAN network in Asia.

A dedicated doctor and lecturer, Dato’ Dr Salem was not short of admirers among students and patients who came to UMMC. According to Professor Dato’ Dr K L Goh who was then Head of Medicine as well as Head of Gastroenterology “When Salem first joined me in the unit after passing his Masters of Medicine examination in 1999, he was already dedicated to achieving excellence in what he would do. I was impressed and enthused by his positive attitude. I remember the many evenings when he came to my office at the Department of Medicine discussing what he should do if he could get a University scholarship.” His career in Gastroenterology was carved out when he pursued training in Endoscopic Ultrasound, via a scholarship from University of Malaya, in the world famous University Hospital Eppendorf, University of Hamburg, Germany, under the legendary Professor Nib Soehendra. Due to Salem’s absolute diligence and dedication to learning and work, he became very good in the field and was soon teaching younger fellows who had joined the unit. Professor Nib Soehendra liked Salem very much. Before long, Salem was his close confidant and “aide-de camp” who took care of the continuous stream of overseas fellows that visited and worked in the “Mecca” of endoscopy in Hamburg. Through this, Salem built up a huge network of friends - Gastroenterologists from all corners of the globe, particularly in Europe, Japan and South East Asia.

Although the last few years of Salem’s life became a balancing act between attending to his illness and functioning as a doctor, he was fortunate to have a solid rock in the form of his wife, Joanna, and his daughter, Edina, who were an incredible source of support.

In addition to pursuing his specialist interest in Endoscopic Ultrasound, Salem also wrote up a doctoral thesis entitled “Negative Predictive Value of Endoscopic Ultrasound in Exclusion of Pancreatic Cancer” which he submitted for a Doctor of Medicine degree to the University of Malaya despite his illness in 2011. Sadly he was due to receive his doctoral scroll in August 2012 during the University’s convocation ceremony, when he was taken ill by his illness.

We celebrate the memory of Associate Professor Dr Salem Omar and dedicate Endoscopy 2013 to an extra-ordinary colleague of ours.


